1. Bid Award: Asphalt Resurfacing LMIG 2019 -

Resurfacing for the following roads: Lake Ashley Drive, Carnation Court, Blueberry Court, Laurel Landing Blvd., Green Acres Circle North, Green Acres Court, and Key Court. Bill Coleman, Public Works Director, recommends low bidder, Kudzue 3 Trucking & Paving Inc., at \$203,222.36. This project is funded by LMIG 2019 funds. Local match required at 30% will be funded by SPLOST VII for various striping projects.

Bid was awarded to low bid, Kudzue 3 Trucking & Paving, Inc.
