1. Bid Award: Two Pumps for Winn Dixie Pump Station -

Staff recommends low bid, Pump & Process, at \$27,652 each for a total of \$55,304.

Purchase of equipment (including installation) for three 2020 Dodge Chargers (Police Interceptors).

Staff recommends low bid, Dana Safety Supply, for the installed equipment without the AED on three Dodge Chargers, at a total cost of \$53,396.85

Councilman Blount recommended the current bids be thrown out and the items be put out for new bids. Councilman Blount stated we traditionally get more than two bids for this type of work and he wants to make sure we give all vendors a chance to bid.

4. Approval Of: Change Order Number Two for May Creek Drainage Improvements -

An 8" sanitary sewer force main and a 6" water main conflicts with the box culvert installation requiring both to be relocated to provide adequate protection and cover over the utilities. The total length of relocation is 97 LF of 6" water main and 137 LF of 8" force main. The total cost of the necessary work to relocate the utilities is \$22,565.00. The cost includes all labor, equipment, materials and testing as required by Public Works.
