1. Council Appointment to the Kingsland Planning Commission -

2. Council Appointments to Kingsland Convention and Visitors Bureau Authority Board -

According to the KCVB Authority legislation, *"New appointments shall be made when there is a new mayor or city councilperson elected or at the beginning of a new term of a mayor or city councilperson. Appointment of the members of the authority shall be made within 30 days of the date the councilperson or mayor takes office or within 30 days of the first meeting of the mayor and city council in January."*

3. Mayor and Council Appointments to the Kingsland Development Authority Board -

According to the Kingsland Development Authority (KDA) legislation, *"The (Authority) members shall be appointed by the mayor and council of the City of Kingsland... No member shall be mayor nor a member of the council of the City of Kingsland, but there shall be no other disqualification to hold public office by reason of membership in the authority. The (members) shall be appointed for terms of five years. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term by the mayor and council"*. With the election of Councilman Fullilove, his Authority Board seat will need filling. Additionally, the term of a sitting KDA Board member will expire on 1/31/2021. This creates two board seat vacancies on the Kingsland Development Authority Board of Directors. The appointments are made during a council meeting and require a majority vote by Council.

Special Event Permit for a One Day Alcohol Beverage License. Mr. Daniel Black has submitted an application requesting to serve and sell alcohol for the Mardi Gras Festival to be held on February 20, 2021. The event will take place at U.S. Hwy 17 and William Avenue, Kingsland, GA 31548.

9. Approval Of: Assistance to Firefighters Grant Match -

Kingsland Fire Rescue is requesting to submit an application to the Assistance to Firefighter Grant (AFG) program to request equipment and training essential to fire protection and prevention.

The objectives of the AFG program are to provide critically needed resources that equip and train emergency personnel to recognized standards, enhance operational efficiencies, foster interoperability, and support community resilience.

Items being requested include: radios (upgrade to 700/800mhz) \$192,500; extrication \$30,000; extractor washer for bunker gear \$5,000; and fire prevention training \$15,000.

The total request is \$242,500

The required match is \$12,125(5%)

10. Bid Award: Purchase of Heavy Duty Aerial Ladder Truck (107') -

Staff recommends low bid, Ten-8 Fire and Safety, LLC, for one (1) Pierce Heavy Duty Aerial Ladder Truck (107') for \$924,645. Funding is SPLOST 8.

11. Bid Award: Purchase of Equipment and Installation -

Purchase of Equipment and Installation on five (5) Ford Explorer Patrol Interceptors. Staff recommends low bid, West Chatham Warning Devices, at \$17,014.46 each for a total of \$85,072.30. Includes delivery.
