VIII. NEW BUSINESS

1. Appointment to the Kingsland Downtown Development Authority Board -

On April 13, 2023, the Kingsland Downtown Development Authority (KDDA) Board approved the nomination of Jose Rosario, owner of NineTwelve Auto Spa, by ballot voting. As per Section 7 of the KDDA bylaws, the nomination is being submitted to Mayor and Council for their consideration as the official appointment to the Kingsland Downtown Development Authority Board of Directors.

2. Bid Award: Asphalt Resurfacing - LMIG 2023 Funds -

Georgia Department of Transportation's Local Maintenance & Improvement Grant (LMIG) for 2023 allocated \$233,147.97 to Kingsland. A 30% match (\$69,944.39) is required, this is funded from SPLOST 8. Total resurfacing projects must be at a minimum of \$303,092.36.

Staff recommends low bid from East Coast Asphalt for a total of \$332,815. This includes a portion of Eagle Blvd, Foxwood Dr., Redwood Ct., Brackenfern Way, Stonewood Way, Lonesome Pine Ct., Pineneedle Ct., Centerville Rd., and Greentree Circle. Funding source will be LMIG (\$233,147.97) and SPLOST 8 (\$99,667.03).
